## 2. Program of Study

Provide a discussion which addresses to the best of your ability your academic background in international studies and international relations, the general area of international studies on which you wish to concentrate, the global issues which interest you and why, the international relations methods and theories with which you are familiar and which you are likely to employ, the courses you wish to take, the faculty you wish to work with, and possible thesis topics.

**NB:** Entrance into the IMPIS program is a highly competitive process. Much weight is accorded to these essays, as well as to the letters of recommendation, by the IMPIS admissions committee. Receipt of a Ministry of Education or other government scholarship is not a guarantee of admittance to the program.
